

EXPLORE KALUTARA ON WHEELS

Cycle or tuk tuk your way around famous landmarks.....





The Kalutara Bodhiya

Located at the southern end of the 38m Kalutara Bridge, the three-storey Kalutara Bodhiya Temple was built in the 1960s, and holds the distinction of being the only stupa in the world that is hollow, and has inside access.



Richmond Castle

Built at the turn of the century in Kalutara, Richmond Castle is considered to be one of the most spectacular architectural works of the period. Formerly the property of a wealthy landowner turned philanthropist, the mansion stands majestically atop a hill, on a 42-acre estate. Once a circuit bungalow for high-ranking officers of the British administrative service, today it is a popular tourist attraction, and serves as an educational centre for under privileged children in Kalutara.



Thudugala Ella Waterfall

Situated on a former plantation owned during the British occupation, this waterfall is a natural stream pool surrounded by a forest reserve. Though shorter than other waterfalls in Sri Lanka, the nearby forest reserve is home to beautiful migratory birds such as the "Pale Bellied Flower Pecker" - the smallest bird in Sri Lanka.

Guided Cycling Tour—Kalutara Bodhiya & Richmond Castle (2.5 hrs) USD 25 Per Person

Cycle to the revered Kalutara Bodhiya followed by a guided tour of the 18th century Richmond Castle. Quench your thirst with a refreshing king coconut on your way back to the resort.

Guided Cycling Tour—Thudugala Ella Waterfall (4 hrs) USD 35 Per Person

Admire the local sights and sounds as you cycle and walk through Kalutara's nature trails to the Thudugala Ella Waterfall. Enjoy a refreshing dip in the cool water before heading back to the resort via paddy fields and rubber plantations. A stop at a local roadside tea kiosk is a must to taste "plain tea" (tea without milk) with a delicious tea bun.

Tuk Tuk Tour—Kalutara Bodhiya, Richmond Castle & Thudugala Ella Waterfall (5 hrs) USD 50 Per Person

Combine both experiences while travelling like a local!

Jump on a tuk tuk for a cultural tour starting at one of Sri Lanka's most admired temples, followed by exploring an iconic landmark. The trip is topped off with afternoon relaxation at a breathtaking waterfall.
